Mr. Mullis' Letter

January 8, 2025

We will be celebrating Catholic Schools Week, from January 24 through January 31. Throughout that time we have many activities and events planned to highlight our students, teachers, and athletes, and to share with others through our Buddy day, Service day, and Grandparent's day. Be sure to check out the details for the week in today's newsletter, especially the form for Grandparent's day.

January 15 is the first day families can pick up a Financial Aid packet for the 2025-2026 school year. The packet can be picked up in the school office. All completed packets must be returned by February 28 with a copy of your 2024 tax returns.

Also, this is the time of year that families may apply for the Tennessee Education Savings Account. To apply for these funds, you must live within the Shelby County School District, be entering Kindergarten (or attended a public school the year prior), and meet the financial threshold for your household. If you qualify, you can be eligible for an approximately \$9,500 allotment, which can be used for your child's tuition and book fees, as well as, a few other items. Another option is M.O.S.T., a local private trust that provides scholarship to students in the Memphis area. Families can seek help so that they can afford to send their child to a private school. The application for M.O.S.T. is online. If you would like more information on it, search for Memphis Opportunity Scholarship Trust. Once you are on their website, you will find more information and the application. If you need help with either of these opportunities, please reach out to us and we will be glad to help you.

As a reminder, please notify the school by January 24, if your child will not be returning to Holy Rosary. If you notify us by January 24, we will refund your 2025-2026 re-enrollment fee. After that date, the re-enrollment fee is non-refundable.

This morning I emailed out the Inclement Weather policy. Please be sure to read over it and let me know if you have any questions.

Touching Safety Opt Out Form

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Every year at Holy Rosary we teach a **Touching Safety Lesson** for our students in Grades 3K-8, as mandated by the Catholic Diocese of Memphis.

The lessons focus on an age appropriate discussion of touching safety, relative to specific roles that different people play in a child's life. All the lessons stress the importance of keeping private body parts "private" and of telling a trusting adult or friend about anyone's behavior that causes a child to feel uncomfortable or threatened.

These lessons further help children and young people to develop the vocabulary and boundary distinctions necessary to empower them to begin to recognize inappropriate behavior by others, while practicing appropriate relationship boundaries in their own lives.
